

How to...

make a festive tea candle holder, using sustainable materials



What you will need:

- \bigstar A large jar
- ★ Some moss, just a little bit, collected from your garden or park
- ★ Dried orange and apple peels (optional) or Spices: star anise and cinnamon or cassia sticks.
- ★ A candle
- ★ A festive ribbon, preferably red or red and white





Steps:

1



Start by choosing your moss, tear small pieces and place them onto the bottom of your jar or jars. Push these down so the moss is even.

Place your candle on your moss pile and push a little moss around the base of the candle so it stands well on the moss.

Decorate around the candle using dried orange pieces or spices.

Make sure these lean against the jar not the candle itself to avoid anything burning when the candle burns down.

Decorate the jar with a red or red and white ribbon, wrap the ribbon many times around the top and then tie a bow.





Finally stand your festive candle holders in the room, use them as Christmas lighting and watch the candles burn.
